



Misplaced iPads and iCloud

Students sometimes misplace their iPads or get their iPad mixed up with another student's. There are a few cautionary steps you and the students can take ahead of time that will help in that situation.

1. Simply have the student's first and last name somewhere on the iPad case, preferably somewhere that can be seen without removing the iPad from the case. Found iPads should be turned in to the library or front office. We can then look up the student's schedule if we have their name and quickly get their iPads back to them.
2. Have the parent or student logged into iCloud and switch on the Find my iPad option on the student's iPad. (<https://support.apple.com/en-us/HT205362>) Then if a device is misplaced, when iCloud is logged into the Find iPhone app on a different device, you can see where the misplaced device is roughly on a map, you can make it beep, and there are a few additional options as well.
